

# India and Bahrain revise bilateral agreement on air services

The Governments of India and the Kingdom of Bahrain met in New Delhi on 29-30 January 2008 to review the Bilateral Air Services Agreement between the two countries.

While agreeing on designation of multiple airlines both countries also decided to enhance the existing traffic entitlement to 11,500 seats per week in each direction with immediate effect. For the Kingdom of Bahrain, Hyderabad has been

included as an additional point of call besides Mumbai, Delhi, Chennai, Bangalore, Kochi and Kolkata. The designated carriers of India for Bahrain can use any points in Asia including points in UAE, Oman and Qatar as 'intermediate points' and any points in Europe, North America, Asia including points in UAE, Oman and Qatar as 'beyond points'.

Both parties have also decided to remove all limitations on the cargo services.
