NAMIBIA: IMPORT / EXPORT PROCEDURES

Namibia, being a member of the Southern African Customs Union (SACU) is obliged to apply a SACU-wide import and export management regime. All cross-border movement of goods are subject to a general import and export licensing system, which is largely automatic. The Ministry of Trade and Industry is the first entry point for enquiries regarding import and export licensing, but other public agencies are also involved depending on the type of product being imported or exported.

There are specific groups of products requiring import permits, of which the following are not automatically granted:

- Medicine and related substances
- Chemicals
- Frozen, chilled fish and meat, including game
- Live animals and genetic materials
- Pornographic materials
- Controlled agronomic products (maize, wheat and dairy products)
- Controlled petroleum products
- Firearms, explosives, etc
- Diamond, gold and other minerals
- Coins
- All second hand and used goods such as used clothes and vehicles

The following specific groups of products require export permits, and are also not automatically granted:

- Medicine and related substances
- Live animals and genetic materials
- All ostrich breeding materials (eggs, chicks, birds)
- Meat and game products
- Protected species (fauna/flora) in terms of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species (CITES)
- Plants, plant products, and propagating materials
- Firearms, explosives, etc
- Diamond, gold and other minerals
- Coins and bank notes
- Works of art which have been in Namibia for more than 50 years
- National monuments, archaeological findings, etc.

Namibia is party to the WTO Agreement on Import Licensing, and as such, its import and export management regime has to be gradually made compatible with the WTO parameters on import controls. Unlike imports, exports are not so much an issue of concern within the WTO rules. Namibia is also a signatory to the following:

- Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species (CITES)
- Montreal Convention on the Emission of Ozone Depleting Substances
- International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA)
- International Organisation for Epizootic (IOE)
- World Intellectual Property Organisation (WIPO)
- International Standards Organisation (ISO)

All these international commitments require certain, specified interventions in the trade of species, substances, materials and goods.

A national investment promotion agency of Mozambique was started in 1984, but in its current form as CPI, has only been in existence since the new law on investments was passed in 1993. The three year plan of 1997 saw sweeping changes being implemented which ushered in a complete restructuring of CPI, towards creating a world class investment promotion agency. A number of new divisions were created, and this framework has allowed CPI to really come into its own over the past 3 to four years (although it still is in the process of re-engineering).

CPI offers a comprehensive service in support of foreign investors wishing to invest anywhere in the country. It is made up of a number of divisions which are under the control of the director. The main divisions of the organization are the:

- Facilitation division - which provides technical assistance and support to the investor to the investor throughout the period of application.
- The Research division - which produces investment and country information.
- Industrial Free Zone division - which provides special support to major projects in the country, and examines the linkages to the local economy.
- Linkage division - which help local businesses, to participate in the current and future industrial development in the country and maximize the number and amount of materials, and services supplied locally by Mozambican businesses.

Some of the services provided by the CPI include:

- Information about the investment law
- Registering investment project proposals
- Assistance in registering new companies related to investment projects
- Facilitating the approval of submitted projects
- Identification of investment opportunities
- Lending advice and support to investors.

IST-AFRICA CONFERENCE AND EXHIBITION

The Tanzania Commission for Science and Technology (COSTECH) has joined forces with a number of partners in an initiative focused on reducing the digital divide in sub-Saharan Africa. Called the *Regional Impact of Information Society Technologies in Africa* (IST-Africa), the initiative brings together several partners in the business of promoting ICT for development, namely: ICT Policy Implementation Technical Unit (UTICT) in Mozambique; Council for Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) in South Africa; Commonwealth Network of Information Technology for Development (COMNET-IT) in Malta and COSTECH in Tanzania. As a group they are coordinated by the International Information Management Corporation Limited (IIMC) in Ireland and receive support from the European Union.

Some of the initiatives main objectives are:

- Promote dissemination and exploitation of IST research results in Sub-Saharan Africa
- Develop training modules for eGovernment, eHealth, eLearning, ICT for agriculture and ICT sensitization
- Organize two international conferences in Africa on information society technologies to facilitate European Union (EU) Africa and Caribbean and Pacific Countries (ACP) networking and highlighting IST exploitation and international cooperation.

In pursuit of one of the above objectives the project is organizing the IST-Africa Conference and Exhibition, which will be held in Pretoria, South Africa, from 3 to 5 May 2006.

INVESTMENT OPPORTUNITIES IN BOTSWANA

Botswana is a country with GDP of some US\$ 10.4 billion (PPP) for population of only 15,86,119. It is vastly different from rest of Africa in terms of per capita income, political stability, foreign exchange reserves and trade balance. Except in terms of social indicators like life expectancy, lowered by HIV infection, it ranks among the highest income country in the developing world. As a result, the country has attracted investments from Europe, Asia & Africa including India. It is, however, a small market dominated by South Africa. Export of goods from India is therefore limited. However, the country provides attractive opportunity for investment and trade in services.

Companies interested in setting up of joint venture in Botswana can contact Botswana Export Development and Investment Authority (BEDIA), Plot No. 28, Matsitama Road, P.O. Box 3122, Gaborone. Other Government offices also provide financial and other assistance for foreign

investors if the investment is involved in manufacturing and generation of local jobs. BEDIA can provide useful information for investors from India. Tanzania, Omani national carriers announce partnership

Air Tanzania and Oman Air have announced a new partnership of code share flight arrangement.

The agreement was signed last Friday [30 September] between the two airlines whereby doors have been opened to access new destinations. Air Tanzania is to be connected to Muscat, Dubai and Mumbai from Dar es Salaam and Zanzibar. At the same time, Oman Air passengers from Muscat and Dubai can fly as far as Mwanza, Mtwara and Kilimanjaro and up to Johannesburg and the Comoros.

There will be four flights on Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday leaving Dar es Salaam at 1715 [local time] in the evening arriving Muscat at 15 minutes before midnight [local time]. On another leg, the flight is to leave Muscat at 10.30 a.m. and arrive Dar es Salaam by 16.15 p.m.

Tanzania in Desperate Need of Urban Housing, Minister Says

With an average of seven out of 10 urban dwellers living in unplanned homes, Tanzania is undertaking a programme to survey and upgrade hundreds of thousands of plots in its major urban cities to improve human settlement, Lands Minister Gideon Cheyo said on Monday.

He said the upgrading programme was aimed at improving the living conditions for millions of urban residents living in squalid conditions

He said that in most Tanzanian urban areas, only 74 percent of the people had access to clean water, while only 53 percent of their rural counterparts had access to this resource.

Already, he added, about 34,300 plots had been surveyed and upgraded in the commercial city of Dar es Salaam and the lakeside city of Mwanza in the past three years.

Tanzania Firm to Sell Herbal Tea in Kenya

A Tanzanian company yesterday secured a Sh37.5 million contract to supply herbal teas in Kenya.

Tanzania Tea Packers Group will partner with a Kenyan businessman, Dr Maina Mwea, of Dr Maina herbal clinic.

The deal was announced yesterday by the head of the Tanzanian delegation to the Nairobi International Trade Fair, Mr Dominicus Ulikaye.

Mr Ulikaye said the Tanzanian company was moving into niche teas, such as the herbal brands to be sold in Kenya.

Dr Mwea said Kenyan buyers of herbal tea were turning to Tanzania because of good prices and high quality packaging.

Zambia Warming Up for Arusha-Nairobi Power Line

Zambia is looking forward to the construction of the Arusha to Nairobi electricity transmission line as the project will enhance the country's chances of exporting its surplus power to electricity-deprived, East African members states, especially Kenya and Tanzania.

Recently, Tanzania Kenya and Zambia agreed to speed up the implementation of yet another power project, the interconnection line which is set to link up their power grids before 2009, the official newspaper of Zambia; The Times reported

Major Investments Planned in Mozambican Airports

Mozambique's publicly owned airport company, ADM, intends to invest 60 million US dollars over the next five years in modernising its infrastructures, including Maputo International airport, by far the largest airport in the country.

Speaking on Wednesday at the opening of a meeting analysing the company's activities so far this year, and its plan and budget for 2006, the chairman of the ADM board, Jose Cossa, said that among the other challenges were renovation work on runways at Vilankulo in the south of the country, Quelimane in the centre, and Pemba and Lichinga in the north.

Nigerian Govt Signs \$3.6 Billion Lease on Terminal

Federal Government rounded off transactions on the privatisation of Apapa Container Terminal complex, Lagos by signing a 25-year concessioning agreement with a Dutch firm, A. P. Moller Terminals for \$3.6 billion.

The agreement automatically confers on the private firm, legal take-over of the management and operatorship of the port facility for a period of 25 years.

Under the agreement, the company is to pay \$10 million as contract signing fee while other payments are to be spread over the 25 year lease period.

Donor Report Praises Kenya Trade Reforms

Kenya is rated among the best five black African countries, according to a new World Bank survey of factors that deter starting and operating a private business

In Doing Business in 2006: Creating Jobs, the bank praises the country for amending the Banking Act, making it easier for lenders to assess credit.

Kenya is ranked among the best African performers in several categories assessed by the bank, including the cost of starting a business.

South Africa, at the 27th place globally, is the highest-ranked black African country. Kenya is 68th, behind Namibia (33), Botswana (40) and Zambia (67).

South Africa Moves Up Economic Freedom Index

South Africa has been lauded as an economically free country by a recent Fraser Institute report that defines economic freedom using variables such as size of government, legal structures and security of property rights, and freedom to trade with foreigners.

Chinese Investors Interested in Uganda

CHINESE investors have shown interest in road maintenance, agricultural and construction sectors.

Uganda National Chamber of Commerce and Industry (UNCCI) director, John Ndyomugenyi, said on Monday, "During my tour in China, I had an opportunity to discuss with different property magnates who have shown interest in investing in Uganda especially in the road, agricultural and construction sectors."

Nyomugenyi returned from a three-week tour to China recently.
