INVEST IN ANGOLA: BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES FOR INDIA

Natural Resources available

- Angola's soil is endowed with abundant riches and priceless treasures.
- The country is described as one of the world's biggest and least explored mineral treasure troves.
- Out of the 45 most important minerals in the world trade 35 are found in Angola which include Petroleum, Natural Gas, Diamonds, Phosphates, Bitumen Substances, Iron, Copper, Magnesium, Gold and Ornamental Rocks.

Angola's Location is favorable

- Angola's geography and resources make it a central part of Southern Africa.
- Angola has close links with the rest of the Southern Africa and has links with Central Africa which forms a major market.
- Angola has 1600 kilometers of coastline with 3 major ports, which make it a natural trans shipment point for the region

Treaties and Relations

Angola has many formal trade and treaty links.

- Angola is a member of the Southern African Development Community (SADC) formed in 1992.
- Angola is a member of –
 - United Nations
 - Organisation of Africa Unity
 - Africa Union
 - CPLP (Community of Portuguese Speaking Countries)
 - PALOPS (African Countries with Portuguese as the Official Language)
- Angola is a member of the Economic Community of Central Africa (ECCA).

Fiscal Incentives:

- Tax exemption from profits or dividend for a period of 5 -10 years to new investment in the interior of the country and areas declared as development centre. • Industrial Contribution exemption upto 50% for a period of upto 5 years for those investments that use national inputs of no less than 60%.

Export incentives:

- Exemption from custom taxes for certain products in the automatic list.
- Reduction in the industrial contribution, calculated according to the share of profit applicable to the exporting activity for companies exporting more than 50% of their production valued on factor costs.

Customs Incentives:

- Exemption or reduction of upto 50% of taxes on imports of equipment good and raw material within the automatic list. • Total exemption of products in the automatic list for investment in the priority centre zones of development, or for a period of 3 years for the interior zones of the country.

Rights & Guarantees of the Investor

- The firms constituted are protected by the law of Foreign Investment.
- They have all the legal effects and statute of Angolan firms.
- Common Angolan law is applicable.
- The State of Angola makes sure that the treatment is just, without discrimination and equal for every enterprise constituted.
- The imports are protected.
- The foreign investor is guaranteed property rights namely the right of transferring funds to foreign countries in terms of exchange legislation.

- The firms constituted in the circuit of the law of foreign investment, have the same fiscal benefits as the Angolan firms.
- The foreign promoter has finally the request for the internal and external financing for his investments.
- Additional benefits are still included for the investor who develops relevant actions of social or promotes formation courses in favour of local jobs.

Obligations of the Investor

- To respect the legislation in force, as well as contract engagements.
- Should give all the information solicited by the competent authorities.
- To respect the norms relative to environmental protection and hygiene.
- Protection and security of workers against professional sickness, accidents in the work place and other eventualities anticipated in the legislation of social security.
- To fulfill and maintain insurance against accidents and professional sickness of the workers.
- To maintain accounts according to the rules of accounting in Angola.
- To maintain accounts of national and foreign exchange in Bank domiciled in the country as priority and all payments internal and external should take place through this.
- To discharge fiscal legislation in force.

Taxation

The tax dues of the enterprises that function through the Foreign Investment decree are basically:

- The Industrial tax: Takes into account only profits of activities of Commercial and Industrial nature being a tax of 40% on income higher than KZR 10,000,000,00.
- Stamp Duty is determined on the basis of invoices produced between 1% to 10% over sale transactions or over bank interest.
- Capital Taxes: Takes into account profits or dividends, being a tax of 5%.

Angola : Resources

Oil:

Angola is the second largest oil producer in Sub-Sahara Africa.

Oil accounts for 90% of total exports, more than 80% of govt. revenues and 42% of country's GDP. Approximately 15 foreign companies including Chevron, Texaco, Exxon and Occidental have invested more than \$8 billion in Angola. Oil companies are attracted by Angola's low operation costs, favorable geology and good business terms. Business opportunities in this field are made through agreements of joint venture or PSA. Four new off shore fields are discovered with 300 million barrels of recoverable oil. Angola produces more than a million barrels today.

Diamonds:

Angola was the world's 4th largest producer of diamonds before 1975. It is estimated that Angola's alluvial reserves total between 40 and 130 million carats in addition to the untapped diamond reserves in volcanic pipes called Kimberlite. Angola's 6 known Kimberlite pipes ranks among the 10 largest on earth and holds an estimated 180 million carats. Angola announced changes to its production program, which outlines its goals to produce more than 2 million carats of diamonds annually.

Other Minerals:

Angola is one of the world's largest and least explored mineral treasure troves. Substantial deposits of gold, iron ore, phosphates, manganese, copper, lead, quartz, gypsums, marbles, black granite, beryl, zinc and numerous base and strategic metals are found. The Government has developed a policy framework to encourage investment in mining. The Government has ended the state monopoly on geological studies and mineral prospecting. The Government will award concession to both foreign and national companies for prospecting as well as production.

Agriculture:

The UN estimates that the country has from 5 to 8 million hectares of prime agricultural land as well as areas suitable for grazing. The country's climatic zones enable farmers to grow a wide crop which include cassava, yams, maize, bananas, beans, cotton, palm oil, potatoes, sun flowers, citrus and numerous vegetables. Since 1994 Angola is improving its output and is making a recovery and the coffee production is projected to reach 120,000 tons soon. Angola has submitted a plan to the International Coffee Organisation to overhaul to sector. The Govt. has decided to liquidate all 33 state owned coffee companies and invite International investors to bid under its privatization policy.

Timber:

Angola has considerable valuable timber resources which have been untapped since independence. The valuable tree species include Rosewood, Ebony, African Sandalwood, Mahogany, Tola and Mulberry. Nearly 150,000 hectares of Eucalyptus, Cypress and Pine plantation are waiting to be rehabilitated

Fisheries:

Angola has 1650 Kms. long coastline which offers some of the richest fishing grounds in Africa. The annual catch once averaged 30,000 tons a year. Angola has set up the Angolan Support Fund for Fisheries development to support the development of the industry with the help of the World Bank. The US Trade and Development agency has commissioned a feasibility study on the potentially lucrative fisheries sector.

Energy and Electric Power Generation:

Angola possesses enormous hydroelectric potential because of the large and powerful rivers. The 520 MW Capanda Hydro-Electric dam on Kwanza river will double Angola's generating capacity and will provide enough power to meet the country's need for the next 4 decades when completed. Angola could be a regional exporter of hydroelectric energy as it generates more electricity than needed. Angola is part of an international consortium to develop power stations along its borders with Namibia.

Manufacturing:

The manufacturing sector of Angola employed 200,000 people and produced \$650 million worth of goods before independence. Angola previously produced sugar, wheat flour, cooking oil, textiles, soaps, paint, plastic and glues. Heavy Industry cement and steel tube production account for about 15% of the country's manufacturing output. With an infusion of capital, technology and training, food processing and light industry will recover quickly.

Tourism:

Angola is a country with rich touristic resources with places of interest like Luanda, Benguela and Huila. Natural Parks with rare animal species like the Big black antelope, Zebra, large herds of elephants are seen. In the rivers and lagoons hippotamus and crocodiles are prominent. White rhinoceros are also found.

Places of tourist attraction include :

- The famous creek of Tundavala.
- Mountain range of Leba in the province of Huila.
- The Falls of Calendula.
- Rocks of Pungo-A-N-Dongo, Miradouro de Lua.

Angola possess a maritime coast of 1650 Kms. full of beaches with excellent natural condition not only for bathing and swimming but also for water sports. Angola has its own Bantu culture based in African history and tradition. The influence of Latin culture mainly in the music, dance and food is seen.

Angola : Transportation

Road Transport:

- The road network covers about 75000 Kms. of which 7955 Kms. are asphalted.
- The Principle axis joins the capital with the interior in the East West direction.
- The secondary branches are interlined among themselves and the principle axis.
- They permit communication with the country on its boundaries in particular with Namibia, Democratic Republic of Congo and Republic of Congo.

Rail Transport:

Angola possess a rail network of 2750 Kms. in 3 axis not intercommunicated and of which 2 are inter provincial route and one on the intercontinental route.

Waterways and Shipping:

- It is the principal means of external trade.
- Angola has 3 important ports of trade and other small ports for small scale operations like fishing and oil rigging.
- Angolan rivers offer opportunities for business of tourist interest or a mixture of commerce and tourism

Air transport:

A network of airports and aerodromes are spread all over the country. Angola has an international airport in the capital. TAAG (Angolan Airlines) is the national airline operates in the whole country and has links with the capitals in Africa, Europe and America. Other airline companies too operate in Angola which offer both cargo and transport service.
